RESOLUTION NO. 2024-02

A Resolution for the Purpose of Approving Changes to the FY 2023-2024 Budget by Increasing Appropriations in the Park Fund Due to Unanticipated Expenses

WHEREAS, a budget resolution to transfer appropriation authority between funds is allowed under ORS 294.463 is necessary; and

WHEREAS, an occurrence, which had not been anticipated at the time of the preparation of the budget, which requires a change in financial planning has taken place; and

WHEREAS, an increase in appropriations is necessary to fund this expense; and

WHEREAS, these changes are necessary to avoid an over-expenditure of budgetary spending authority in the Stormwater Drainage Fund due to the unforeseen expenses regarding the flooding occurring on December 5, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Wheeler Emergency Team has authorized a donation of funds towards this project; and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Wheeler hereby adopts the following FY 2023-2024 budget changes in the Stormwater Drainage Fund(s) as follows:
